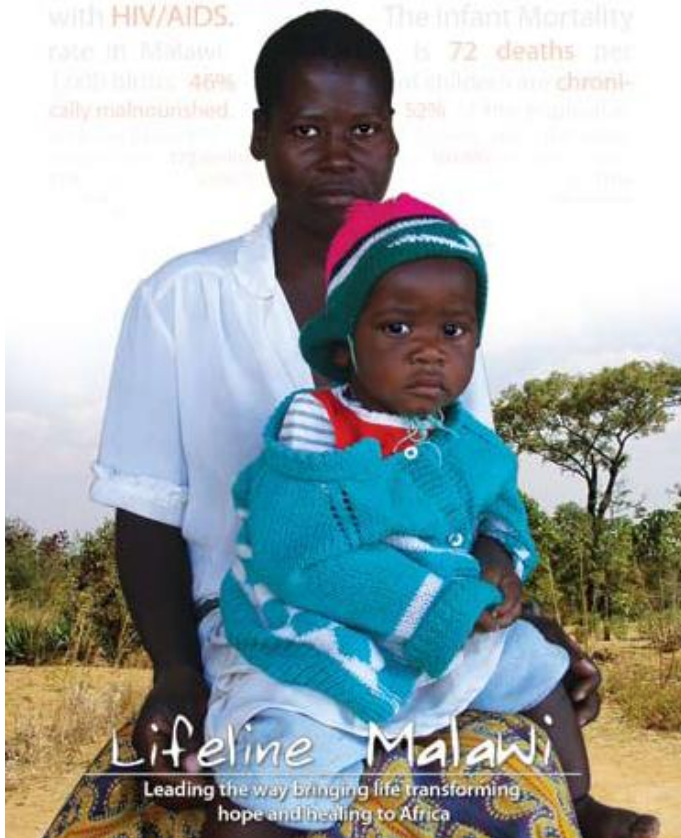


MALAWI NEEDS YOUR HELP

are 1,000,000 people infected
with the HIV/AIDS virus in Malawi.
More than 100,000 children are living

The infant Mortality
rate in Malawi is 72 deaths per
1,000 births. 46% of children are chroni-
cally malnourished.

Malawi – the warm heart of Africa

Why Malawi? Situated in South Eastern Africa, the small country of Malawi is known as “The warm heart of Africa”. Despite the genuine warmth of these people, the majority live under the enormous multiple burdens of poverty and disease. The health statistics for Malawi are some of the worst in the world.

Orphans & Vulnerable Children:

- 1 in 8 children die before age 5, 1 million orphans in a population of 12 million

HIV/AIDS:

- In various areas of Malawi up to 25% of the population are HIV+

Mothers & Maternity Care:

- 984 out of 100,000 mothers die during childbirth, one of the highest rates in Africa



Primary Health Services:

- With less than 300 doctors for 12 million people, health services are scarce.

Remote rural healthcare:

- Malawi is a rural country with few proper roads, the population’s main transport being bicycles.

Sustainable Community:

- Lifeline Malawi is about helping Malawi to improve and sustain itself.
